

**Day 21~August 21**~Radio-internet communications are impacting Muslims from Morocco to Indonesia. Pray for those who prepare, broadcast and participate in these programs.

**Day 22~August 22**~Pray for the Jordan Evangelical Theological Seminary, the only seminary in all of the Arab-speaking Middle East. Pray that it will meet all government regulations, stay open and be a blessing.

**Day 23~August 23**~Moral decadence in “Christian” America and Europe constrains the appeal of the Gospel in Muslim lands. Pray this will not hinder the expansion of God’s kingdom into new areas.

**Day 24~August 24**~Of six million Muslims in North America, 40% are converts. Two million are African Americans or Hispanics who grew up in a Christian church. Pray for racial reconciliation in the church in America.

**Day 25~August 25**~Indonesia is the largest Muslim country in the world. There are over 13,500 islands divided into 27 provinces and over 40,000 villages that are 100% Muslim with no Christian witness. Pray for revival of the Indonesia church and ministries that are training workers for this vast field.

**Day 26~August 26**~Iraq is the birthplace of civilization. Now it is the center of world attention. Pray for the Kurds in the north and Shi’ites in the south. Pray for resolution of the conflict and for Iraq to humble itself and recognize the need for the God of Peace.

**Day 27~August 27**~The 27th day of Ramadan is remembered each year as the night when Muhammad received the first revelation of the Qur’an. Muslims expect spiritual revelations. Pray for a supernatural move of God to reveal Jesus to many Muslims on this night (Isaiah 52:10; 59:1).

**Day 28~August 28**~Of the 3 billion women worldwide, 23% are Muslims. Three-quarters live under restrictive governments, denied access to education, health care and basic human rights. Pray for education opportunities for girls and women, Christian healthcare workers and God’s justice to reign in these countries.

**Day 29~August 29**~Bangladesh suffers from one of the poorest economies in the world, overpopulation and a series of natural disasters that has caused enormous loss of life and property. Islam is the state religion in Bangladesh, and persecution against Christians has increased in the last year. Pray for the openness of the Gospel and for churches to continue to grow.

**Day 30~August 30**~At sundown today Ramadan is over for this year. Beginning tonight and for the next two days there will be many celebrations. Pray that God will lead Muslims beyond ritual to worship Him in spirit and in truth. Pray God will give opportunities for Christians to share their joy in Christ with their family and friends.

## Ramadan Prayer Guide



**August 01—30, 2011**

The calendar inside is designed to be used during the 30 days of Ramadan, a time when Muslims all over the world will be fasting and praying as an act of faith and worship towards Allah. Over the past several years a growing number of Christians have used this time, while Muslim hearts are especially sensitive to spiritual matters, to lift our voices in prayer for their salvation through Jesus Christ.

The calendar lists areas or unreached people groups with whom CPCC has partnership directed to these populations. Here are some needs you can pray about:

- ◆ Pray that the Holy Spirit will convict Muslims of sin, righteousness and judgment.
- ◆ Pray for God’s power to be shown through the Christian workers among them (if there are any). Pray the workers will not be hindered by Islamic governments.
- ◆ Pray that converts among them will be bold to share their faith despite persecution.

**Day 1 ~ August 01** ~ Today begins the Muslim month of Ramadan and 30 days of daylight fasting from all food and drink. Pray that during this time of heightened spiritual awareness, God will show Himself as the only sure salvation to Muslims worldwide.

**Day 2 ~ August 02** ~ Mali, one of the poorest countries of the world, is proud of its Islamic heritage. Pray for the Tamahaq, Tuaregs, Bella, Sonrais and Fulani Tribes—for God’s truth to penetrate these closed groups and for the Church to emerge.

**Day 3 ~ August 03** ~ There are 3 million Wolof people who are 99% Muslim and resistant to the Gospel. There are 1.5 million Serer in West Africa who are unreached. As both of these groups live in desert areas, pray they would come to know the Living Water.

**Day 4 ~ August 04** ~ India has over 150 million Muslims. Pray for more full-time workers to join the 150 that are now witnessing to the Muslims.

**Day 5 ~ August 05** ~ Qatar may be best known around the world as the home of Al-Jazeera, the controversial satellite news channel which broadcasts in the Arabic language. Pray for effective programming.

**Day 6 ~ August 06** ~ Pakistan has over 18 million Sindhi Muslims with no church and few Christians. Pray God would open this country again for ministry and that Sindhi Christians would be bold, yet wise as they share the God of Abraham.

**Day 7 ~ August 07** ~ Egypt has more Christians than all the other Gulf states combined. For their presence and tenacity, Egypt’s Coptic Christians are begrudged and hated. Pray that God will use them in the intellectual heart of Islam.

**Day 8 ~ August 08** ~ The 10 million Baluch, who were once a nomadic people, have been forced into villages and cities in areas of Pakistan, Afghanistan and Iran. Pray for protection of the few Baluch believers and a movement of the Holy Spirit among the Baluch people.

**Day 9 ~ August 09** ~ The 25 million Berber who live across North Africa need to be reached with the Gospel. Pray for the emerging church and the radio, TV and media projects that are having a profound effect.

**Day 10 ~ August 10** ~ Christians ministering full time to the world’s one billion Muslims are literally less than one in a million. Pray laborers will go where they will be unappreciated and under compensated. (see Romans 10:14-15.) There are at least 150 Muslims residing in Modesto.

**Day 11~ August 11** ~ A growing number of Arabs are coming to “Yeshua” and joining their Messianic Jewish brothers-sisters. Pray that this demonstration of God’s transforming power will influence the world.

**Day 12~August 12** ~Muslims work hard at fasting, praying, alms giving and making the Mecca pilgrimage in order to merit salvation. Pray many will discover a sure salvation in God’s free gift.

**Day 13~August 13** ~In Tajikistan, there is a large percentage of men who work outside the country, so polygamy is accepted. There are also laws restricting religion. Pray for the few believers to be a light and give favor to development agencies who minister to show God’s love..

**Day 14~August 14** ~The Chams of Cambodia are descendants of ancient people and are proud Muslims. The Cham community is now the second largest ethnic minority in Cambodia with half a million people. There are few Christians among the Cham, no church and very little witness. Pray for Christians to begin working effectively among the Cham.

**Day 15~August 15** ~Muslim countries are sending their best and brightest to study at American universities and service schools. Pray they will be well received and positively exposed to the Gospel during their stay. You can befriend a student through Hospitality to International Students (H.I.S.); contact the World Outreach Office for more information.

**Day 16~August 16** ~Extending across the vast area of Eurasia from Turkey in the west to the Sea of Okhotsk in the east, live the Turkic-speaking people groups. Turkish is spoken by 170 million people, and the majority of Turkic people are Muslims. Pray each of these groups would have access to the Gospel.

**Day 1~August 17** ~The Sundanese of Indonesia is one of the world’s largest unreached people groups. Pray for the church planting teams and the leadership development projects directed by the Sundanese Christian Fellowship.

**Day 18~August 18** ~The Bible Society of Uzbekistan recently published the “Proverbs of Solomon.” It is the first book of the Bible ever published in the Uzbek language inside of Uzbekistan. Pray for the effectiveness of God’s Word in this strategic central Asian republic. Praise the Lord for the over 600 churches that have been planted in Uzbekistan, Kyrgyzstan, Turkmenistan, Kazakhstan and Tajikistan since 2000.

**Day 19~August 19** ~The Hui people of China can be traced to the 7th century Tang Dynasty. They are the second largest ethnic minority in China. Pray for opportunities for the Gospel to be heard among this unreached people group. If there are secret believers, pray for encouragement, wisdom and boldness.

**Day 20~August 20** ~Pray God will reach the Kurds who are in four Middle Eastern countries, speak multiple languages and are persecuted by fellow Muslims. Praise God for FM radio that brings them the Good News.
