

<p><b>9. Fri</b> <i>Kozje</i></p> <p><b>The Lausanne movement</b> is a worldwide movement mobilizing evangelical leaders to collaborate for world evangelization. Let's pray through the 15 points of the Lausanne covenant from 1974, as a statement of faith and mission statement for us all.</p> <p>www.lausanne.org/covenant</p>	<p><b>3. THE UNIQUENESS AND UNIVERSALITY OF CHRIST</b> <i>We affirm that there is only one Savior and only one gospel, although there is a wide diversity of evangelistic approaches. We recognize that everyone has some knowledge of God through His general revelation in nature. But we deny that this can save, for people suppress the truth by their unrighteousness. We also reject as derogatory to Christ and the gospel every kind of syncretism and dialogue which implies that Christ speaks equally through all religions and ideologies. Jesus Christ, being himself the only God-man, who gave himself as the only ransom for sinners, is the only mediator between God and people. There is no other name by which we must be saved. All men and women are perishing because of sin, but God loves everyone, not wishing that any should perish but that all should repent. Yet those who reject Christ repudiate the joy of salvation and condemn themselves to eternal separation from God. To proclaim Jesus as "the Savior of the world" is not to affirm that all people are either automatically or ultimately saved, still less to affirm that all religions offer salvation in Christ. Rather it is to proclaim God's love for a world of sinners and to invite everyone to respond to him as Savior and Lord in the wholehearted personal commitment of repentance and faith. Jesus Christ has been exalted above every other name; we long for the day when every knee shall bow to him and every tongue shall confess him Lord. (Gal.1:6-9; Rom.1:18-32; I Tim. 2:5,6; Acts 4:12; John 3:16-19; II Pet. 3:9; II Thess.1:7-9; John 4:42; Matt 11:28; Eph. 1:20,21; Phil. 2:9-11)</i> – Worship Christ our Savior today. Pray that Jesus' love for the lost would be clearly proclaimed across Slovenia.</p>
<p><b>10. Sat</b> <i>Kranjska Gora</i></p>	<p><b>CHURCHES REACHING CHILDREN</b> Pray for God to guide Slovene churches into ways they can reach the children around them. Pray for Christian kids to be strong witnesses.</p>
<p><b>11. Sun</b> <i>Križevci</i></p>	<p><b>PRAY FOR THE CHURCHES OF SLOVENIA</b> Pray for God's blessing on the churches of Slovenia today. Pray for deeper relationships to form between believers and between churches to give us a greater witness to Slovenia.</p>

**MORALITY:** *We want to focus our prayers this week on the moral state of Slovenia. Pray, and if the Lord leads you to do something more specific, do it!*

<p><b>12. Mon</b> <i>Krško</i></p>	<p><b><u>MORALITY: CONSCIENCE</u></b> God has given each person a sense of right and wrong, but we can see standards of morality are changing. Pray for Slovenes' consciences to understand what God says is right and wrong.</p>
<p><b>13. Tues</b> <i>Kungota</i></p>	<p><b><u>MORALITY: TRADITIONAL VALUES</u></b> Many people who are not evangelicals have biblical values; pray that political leaders would hear our voices. Pray that the trend of tolerance of immorality wouldn't make us silent, but that we would, both together and as individuals, "speak the truth in love" to Slovene culture.</p>
<p><b>14. Wed</b> <i>Kuzma</i></p>	<p><b><u>MORALITY: MARRIAGE</u></b> Pray that the legal definition of marriage in Slovenia would remain as between a man and a woman. Pray for courage for politicians who are being pressured to change the laws.</p>
<p><b>15. Thur</b> <i>Laško</i></p>	<p><b><u>MORALITY: MEDIA IMPARTIALITY</u></b> According to www.24kul.si the media has reported little about the parliamentary debates on same-sex marriage and adoption of children by gay couples. Pray for fair, balanced reporting of the media on both sides of moral issues, and for the media not to promote immorality.</p>
<p><b>16. Fri</b> <i>Lenart</i></p>	<p><b><u>MORALITY: SIN vs. SINNER</u></b> Pray for those who are involved in immorality to not only recognize their sin but sense the love Christ and His church have for them, and thus draw them toward God.</p>
<p><b>17. Sat</b> <i>Litija</i></p>	<p><b><u>MORALITY: PRAY FOR SLO. BASED ON I TIM. 2:1-2</u></b> <i>"I urge, then, first of all, that requests, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for everyone—for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness."</i></p>
<p><b>18. Sun</b> <i>Ljubno</i></p>	<p><b><u>MORALITY: PRAY FOR THE CHURCHES OF SLOVENIA</u></b> Pray for God's blessing on the churches of Slovenia today. Pray for Christians to live by true, biblical moral standards.</p>
<p><b>19. Mon</b> <i>Ljutomer</i></p>	<p><b>PRAY FOR SLOVENIA BASED ON PROVERBS 17:9</b> <i>"He who covers over an offense promotes love, but whoever repeats the matter separates close friends."</i></p>
<p><b>20. Tues</b> <i>Log-Dragomer</i></p>	<p><b>PEOPLE WHO HELP US SPIRITUALLY</b> Bless and pray for those who pray for us, who encourage us, who teach us the Word and who advise us through God's Word.</p>

<b>25. Sun</b> <i>Luče</i>	<b>PRAY FOR THE CHURCHES OF SLOVENIA</b> Pray for God’s blessing on the churches of Slovenia today. Pray for God to bless all those in leadership and their families.
<b>26. Mon</b> <i>Lukovica</i>	<b>PRAY FOR SLOVENIA BASED ON MATHEW 13:45-46</b> <i>“Again, the kingdom of heaven is like a merchant looking for fine pearls. When he found one of great value, he went away and sold everything he had and bought it.”</i>
<b>27. Tues</b> <i>Majšperk</i>	<b>“JESUS LOVES ME, THIS I KNOW”</b> A great theologian said the greatest truth he had ever learned was, “Jesus loves me, this I know for the Bible tells me so.” Praise God today for His love for you personally.
<b>28. Wed</b> <i>Makole</i>	<b>STUDENTS</b> Pray for Slovene children and students to do well in their studies and exams as the school year comes to an end.

<b>1. Thur</b> <i>Kanal</i>	<b>SLOVENE MUNICIPALITIES WITHOUT CHURCHES</b> ◀ *Pray for people in the municipalities listed under each date to come to know Christ personally and churches to be planted.
<b>2. Fri</b> <i>Kidričevo</i>	<b>GOOD FRIDAY</b> Take time today to ponder the story of Christ's crucifixion from one of the Gospels. Pray for many who will go to a church today in Slovenia, to truly understand that Christ died for them.
<b>3. Sat</b> <i>Kobarid</i>	<b>RESURRECTION</b> <i>“For the perishable must clothe itself with the imperishable, and the mortal with immortality.”</i> (1 Cor. 15:53). Praise Jesus for His resurrection and for the sure hope we have of resurrection and immortality.
<b>4. Sun</b> <i>Kobilje</i>	<b>PRAY FOR THE CHURCHES OF SLOVENIA - EASTER</b> Pray for God’s blessing on the churches of Slovenia today, that many new people would come to church to hear and believe the Gospel of the resurrection of Jesus Christ.
<b>5. Mon</b> <i>Komen</i>	<b>LOVE AND RESPECT</b> <i>Eph. 5:21-33; I Peter 3:1-7</i> Pray that husbands would love their wives, as Christ loves the church, and that wives would respect their husbands. If a wife respects her husband, he will respond in love. If the husband loves his wife, she will respond with respect. (Eph. 5) Pray we would live by these biblical principles and enjoy the results.
<b>6. Tues</b> <i>Komenda</i>	<b>HAITI, CHILE, TAIWAN</b> Recent earthquakes have left many lacking basic things. Pray for people to find the physical help they need, for protection from further harm, and for their hearts to also turn to God.

Wed</b> <i>Kostanjevica na Krki</i>	<b>PRAY FOR SLOVENIA: SERMON ON THE MOUNT</b> <i>“Therefore, if you are offering your gift at the altar and there remember that your brother has something against you, leave your gift there in front of the altar. First go and be reconciled to your brother; then come and offer your gift. (Mt 5,23-24)</i>
